SWIMMER Jacob Zammit, 14, is outgrowing shoes faster than a rubber plantation can harvest the trees.

The emerging breaststroker is leaving his rivals flat-footed in the pool, so significant is the improvement in his training and race swim

The teenager needs training flippers which are size 15 to 17 and the 170cm tall athlete is growing rap-

Jacob's huge feet are not unlike that of his swimming idol, former Olympic and global champion Ian Thorpe, who boasts size 17 feet.

A few years ago, Jacob was able to get a photograph with Thorpe, which has pride of place at his Leppington home.

Jacob's mother, Madeline, said her son is growing at a rapid rate.

"Jacob has grown about six or seven centimetres in the past few months and I have to buy him new shoes all the time," she said.

"He's had a huge growth spurt, it's amazing.'

The laconic Jacob said his growth spurt has only occured this year.

'I've suddenly grown a lot,'' Jacob said.
